

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REDVERS IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO CONTROL AND REGULATE THE WASTE DISPOSAL SITE.

The Council of the Town of Redvers, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Waste Disposal Site Bylaw and is set out for the collection, removal and disposal of garbage and other refuse accumulated within the Town of Redvers limits.

DEFINITIONS:

2. For the purpose of this bylaw, the following words shall have the meaning given herein:
 - a) "Garbage" means putrescible animal and vegetable remains and by-products resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking and consumption of food but does not include swill of slops or other liquid or semi liquid waste material. Condemned food products or food producing wastes from canneries, slaughterhouses, meat packing plants, vegetable oil plants or similar industries are not included within the meaning of the word "garbage";
 - b) "Refuse" shall be understood to mean all waste material of any kind, except ashes and garbage, and shall include all of the following classifications of "refuse";
 - i. "Household Refuse" shall mean and include bedding, mattresses, carpets, rags, clothing, broken glass, tree branches, yard trimming and all similar substances that accumulate in or originate from a domestic household;
 - ii. "Building/Demolition Refuse and Contractor Refuse" shall mean and include waste materials from excavation, building construction, building repair or alteration, debris from any building removed, destroyed by fire or any other cause;
 - iii. "Commercial/Industrial Refuse" shall mean waste generated by any process of industry, manufacturing, trade or business or the development of natural resource;
 - iv. "Bulk Refuse" means wood, trees, shrubs, stumps, branches;
 - c) "Litter" shall mean miscellaneous waste items of all sorts including but not limited to matchsticks, empty packages, cigarette butts, loose paper, bags, boxes, shavings, and similar light material of any form that may be blown about or carried off by a gust of wind, gum and wrappers, paper cups, bottles, broken glass and any and all materials which when discarded, dropped, placed, blown or carried on to any sidewalk, street, boulevard, land, park, public place or private premises, contributes to untidiness and detracts from town cleanliness.
 - d) "Major Appliances" means a large machine which accomplishes some routine housekeeping tasks, whether in a household, institutional, commercial, or industrial setting. Types of major appliances include, but are not limited to: deep freezers, refrigerator, range, stove, oven, cook top, microwave oven, washing machine, clothes dryer, drying cabinet, dishwasher, air conditioner, water heater, furnace, and trash compactor.
 - e) "Waste Disposal Site" means the municipal waste disposal site located on NW ¼ SEC 18-7-31 1st, Parcel #111904017.
 - f) "Owner" means the occupant, leasee or tenant or the person otherwise in charge of any dwelling, hotel or motel, restaurant, apartment block, office building, public institution or other premises.

REGULATIONS:

3. The Waste Disposal Site will be open to residents of the Town of Redvers use as set by resolution of the Council of the Town of Redvers.
4. There will be no tipping fees.
5. Paperwork including date, first and last name, civic address, whether you are a homeowner or a renter, phone number and signature must be filled out prior to entrance into the Waste Disposal Site.
6. Regulations for depositing wastes at the Town of Redvers Waste Disposal Site are as follows:
 - a) All garbage must be deposited, where instructed to do so, by the Waste Disposal Site Operator.

- b) Persons dumping compost material and bulk refuse must remove all materials such as plastic bags, boxes or containers. There is a pile for clean wood (trees) as well as a compost pile for leaves and grass.
- c) No paper, newspaper, cardboard, tin cans, aluminum cans or other recyclable material will be accepted at the Waste Disposal Site as long as the Town of Redvers maintains their recycling program.
- d) No hazardous wastes, such as and not limited to used oil, will be allowed or accepted at the Waste Disposal Site.
- e) No manure, grain, petroleum wastes, contaminated soils, asbestos material, pesticide containers, slaughter house wastes, dead animals or any other comparable wastes shall be allowed or accepted at the Waste Disposal Site.
- f) No propane or anything containing propane may be disposed of, including outdated propane tanks.
- g) Persons must obtain authorization from council before disposing concrete.
- 7. Commercial and industrial Businesses will be responsible to make arrangements to handle their own disposal waste and refuse.
- 8. Building/demolition and contractors will not be allowed to use this site for dumping and renovation refuse is not accepted.
- 9. No person shall place, dump, or dispose of any waste near or over the gate or fence at the Waste Disposal Site or on any public or private property.
- 10. No person shall remove, disturb, or take away any material, object or thing from the Waste Disposal Site without the express consent from the municipal representative of the Town of Redvers.
- 11. The municipality shall own and have sole right to dispose of all refuse collected and delivered to the waste disposal site. From time to time the Council of the Town of Redvers may appoint a person for the cleaning up and removal of certain wastes from the waste disposal site.
- 12. Every vehicle used for the collection and transportation of garbage and refuse shall be suitably constructed and equipped with adequate covers to prevent loss of any part of the load enroute to the disposal site.
- 13. Absolutely no burning is permitted at the waste disposal site unless carried out by the Town of Redvers or its representative and such burning is carried out according to the regulations as set out by Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management and as permitted by the Clean Air Act of Saskatchewan.
- 14. No person shall deface, destroy, or alter any signs, gates or fencing at the waste disposal site.
- 15. Major appliances free of Freon may be disposed at this site, as Freon is not permitted.

VIOLATIONS:

- 16. Where the administration office or any authorized Town of Redvers representative believes that a person has contravened any provision of this Bylaw, he/she will:
 - a) Be served a Bylaw Warning for the first offence.
 - b) Upon a second offence, a Bylaw Ticket will be issued including a fine of \$500.00.
 - c) Any contravention resulting in a Bylaw Warning or Ticket will be delivered personally or by mail to his/her last known address.
 - d) Upon production of a Bylaw Ticket being issued, pursuant to this section, within thirty (30) days from the issue thereof, together with the payment of the fee to the Administration Office of the Municipality, the person to whom the ticket was issued shall not be liable for prosecution for the contravention in respect of which the ticket was issued.
- 17. Where any person contravenes the same provision of this Bylaw two or more times within one twelve month period, specified payment payable in respect of the second or subsequent contravention will be double the amount of the original fine.
- 18. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, a person to whom a Bylaw Warning and/or Bylaw Ticket has been issued pursuant to this section may exercise his right to defend any charge of committing a contravention of any of the provisions of this Bylaw.
- 19. This bylaw shall come into effect upon final passing thereof.
