

**BYLAW NO. 416/99**

**TOWN OF REDVERS  
REDVERS, SASK.**

The council of the Town of Redvers, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

**1. INTERPRETATION**

(a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the Town of Redvers.

(b) "Angle parking" shall mean the parking of vehicles with the right front wheel drawn up to the curb on the right hand side of the highway, or at a distance of not more than thirty (30) centimetres from such curb, the vehicle to be placed at an angle of forty-five (45) degrees with the curb.

(c) "Bicycle" shall mean a non-motorised two wheeled means of conveyance of persons.

(d) "Boulevard" shall mean that portion of a highway between the curb of the roadway and the adjoining property line, exclusive of the sidewalk, also that portion of a highway between the inside curbs of a divided roadway.

(e) "Council" shall mean the Council of the Town of Redvers.

(f) "Curb" shall mean the lateral boundaries of a roadway, whether or not marked by curbing.

(g) "Heavy Vehicle" means a vehicle with or without load which alone or together with any trailer, semi-trailer or other vehicle being towed, weights 5500 kilograms or more.

(h) "Highway" means a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area and does not include a provincial highway within the municipality as designated pursuant to the provisions of The Highways Act and Transportation Act.

(i) "Lane" shall mean:

- (i) Any public way 6.2 meters or less in width or,
- (ii) Any highway intended primarily to give access to the rear of property.

(j) "Lug vehicle" shall mean any vehicle portable engine or traction engine having metal spikes, lugs or cleats projecting from the face of the wheels or tires thereof, or having metal track tread.

(k) "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Redvers.

(l) "Parades" shall mean any group of pedestrians except the armed forces, marching or walking on any highway and

numbering twenty or more, and any group of vehicles numbering eight or more proceeding under a common leadership, except funeral processions, shall be deemed a parade.

(m) "Parking" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by The Highway Traffic Act.

(n) "Parallel parking" shall mean the parking of a vehicle with both right wheels thereof drawn up to the curb on the right hand side of the highway, or at a distance of not more than thirty (30) centimetres from such curb.

(o) "Place of public assembly" shall mean schools, theatres, moving picture theatres, churches, hockey and skating rinks, dance halls, and public assembly halls, parks or any other public place where people gather.

(p) "Sidewalk" shall mean that part of public right-of-way intended for the use of pedestrians.

(q) "Special constable" shall mean the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or a person appointed by council to enforce municipal bylaws.

(r) "Speed Zone" shall mean any portion of a highway within the Town of Redvers, as designated herein, and identified by a sign erected and maintained at each end thereof, indicating the maximum speed applicable thereto.

(s) "U-Turn" shall mean the turning of a vehicle so as to cause it to proceed in the opposite direction from which it was proceeding immediately prior to the commencement of such turn.

(t) "Vehicle" shall mean a vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer or a motor vehicle as ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.

## 2. SCOPE

(a) "STOP" STREETS

The streets and avenues as listed in Appendix 1 are designated as "Stop" streets.

(b) "YIELD" STREETS

The streets and avenues as listed in Appendix 2 are designated as "Yield" streets.

(c) "NO U-TURN" INTERSECTIONS

The intersections of streets and avenues, approached from all four (4) directions as listed in Appendix 3 are designated as "No U-Turn" intersections.

(d) "LOADING ZONES"

The highway locations as listed in Appendix 4 are designated as "Loading Zones".

## 3. INFRACTIONS

(a) "STOP" STREETS

The provisions of The Highway Traffic Act shall apply to all traffic approaching and facing a "stop" sign erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of section 4(a).

(b) "YIELD" STREETS

The provisions of The Highway Traffic Act shall apply to all traffic approaching and facing a "Yield" sign erected and maintained in accordance with Section 4(b).

(c) MISCELLANEOUS SIGNS

i) No person shall, except where authorised by resolution of council or when duly authorised by law, erect upon or immediately adjacent to any highway, any sign, marker, signal or light or any advertising sign or device.

ii) No person shall deface, damage, destroy or remove any sign or marker erected pursuant to this bylaw.

(d) LUG VEHICLES

i) No person shall propel, operate or drive any lug vehicle upon any highway within the municipality without first having obtained from the administrator, a permit in writing authorising same.

ii) The administrator is hereby authorised to issue permits in writing for the purpose of Section 3(d)(i) of this bylaw in any case where the applicant therefore has signed a written undertaking in Form 1, Appendix 5. Provided that the clerk shall not issue any such permit unless he is satisfied that with reasonable care in operation, the lug vehicle may be propelled or driven over any highway without damage resulting thereto or to any bridge or culvert thereon.

iii) Nothing contained in Section 3(d)(i) shall be deemed to preclude the transport of a lug vehicle as herein defined over any highway where same is being carried by means of a conveyance equipped with rubber tires.

(e) PARKING

i) Except as otherwise provided herein, the parking of vehicles is permitted on all highways within the municipality.

ii) (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection (b) no person shall park a vehicle in any lane, nor in any highway so as to obstruct the entrance to any lane, or to a driveway, or to an approach leading to private premises.

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) a vehicle may be parked in any lane for the purpose of taking on or discharging cargo, provided no such vehicle shall be so parked for a period exceeding thirty (30) minutes at one time, unless written permission has first been obtained from the administrator or a special constable of the municipality for an extension of such time limit.

iii) No person shall park a vehicle in any area listed in Appendix 9 "Handicapped Parking Zones" other than a vehicle (a) displaying the Special Identification licence plate carrying the International sign of the disabled on the rear or the rear and front of the vehicle; or

(b) conspicuously displaying a placard carrying the International sign of the disabled together with an identification number; or  
(c) both (a) and (b) above.

iv) No person shall park a vehicle (a) displaying the Special Identification licence plate carrying the International sign of the disabled on the rear or the rear and front of the vehicle; or

(b) conspicuously displaying a placard carrying the International sign of the disabled together with an identification number; or

(c) both (a) and (b) above.

in any area listed in Appendix 8 "Handicapped Parking Zones" unless said vehicle is transporting a handicapped person.

v) No person shall park a vehicle on a sidewalk or boulevard unless written permission to so park has been issued by the administrator or a special constable of the municipality.

vi) (a) No person parking a vehicle upon a highway in areas listed in Appendix 6 shall parallel park same.

(b) No person parking a vehicle upon a highway in areas other than those listed in Appendix 6 shall angle park same.

vii) No person shall park a vehicle in any "NO PARKING" area as designated in appendix 8 at any time whether such areas are marked on the curb or otherwise erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of Section 4(d) to indicate that parking therein is prohibited.

viii) No person shall park a vehicle within three (3) meters of any street intersection or within five (5) meters of any fire hydrant.

ix) No person shall park a vehicle on any highway at any one place for any period of time exceeding twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.

x) No person shall park a vehicle in any private parking place or on any private property unless he is the owner occupant, licensee or permittee of the parking place or private property, except with the consent of such owner, occupant, licensee or permittee.

xi) No person shall park a vehicle in any "HANDI VAN PARKING ONLY" area designated in Appendix 7 at any time other than the Handi Van.

xii) (a) Subject to subsection (b), no person shall park any vehicle carrying or designed or intended for the carrying of oil, gasoline or other inflammable, combustible or explosive material, within thirty (30) meters from any place in the municipality used or intended for use in whole or in part as a place of public assembly, or a hotel, or a place of dwelling.

(b) Nothing in subsection (a) shall be deemed to restrict the parking of such vehicle for such period of time, not exceeding two (2) hours, to take on or discharge cargo.

xiii) No person shall park a vehicle with a weight in excess of 5500 kg. on any highway.

xiv) No vehicle shall be parked with the engine running unless in the control of a licensed operator.

(f) CONTROL OF PARADES

i) No parade shall be held without first obtaining written permission from the administrator, who shall designate or approve the hour and route of each parade.

ii) No driver or pedestrian shall drive, ride or walk through any funeral procession, military manoeuvre or procession, or parade or in any way obstruct or interfere with same.

(g) SPEED

i) Subject to subsection (ii), no person shall operate a vehicle in the municipality at a speed greater than forty (40) km/hr.

ii) No person shall operate a vehicle at a speed greater than thirty (30) km/hr. in the speed zones as set out in Appendix 10.

iii) The provisions of subsections (i) and (ii) shall not apply to the operators of fire engines or fire department apparatus or to vehicles being operated by special constables or to operators of ambulances.

(h) WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS - HEAVY VEHICLE ROUTES

1) No person shall operate a vehicle or a combination of vehicles when the weight of the vehicle(s) with or without a load exceeds 5500 kilograms, except on a highway within the municipality designated as a Heavy Vehicle Route as listed in Appendix 11.

2) subject to subsection (1), no person shall operate a vehicle or a combination of vehicles when the weight of the vehicle(s) with or without a load exceeds the maximum allowable weight pursuant to the Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 1988 on any highway within the municipality.

3) Subsections (1) and (2) and Section 3(f)(xi) shall not apply to vehicles making delivery on any highway in the municipality provided that the operator of the vehicle(s) uses the most direct route from and to the heavy vehicle route.

4) The provisions of The Police Act and The Highways and Transportation Act shall apply to the operators of vehicles referred to in subsections (1) and (2).

(i) U - TURNS

i) No person shall cause a vehicle to make a U-Turn at the intersections designated as "NO U-TURN" (Appendix 3) intersections. This shall apply to all traffic approaching and facing a "No U-Turn" sign erected and maintained in accordance with the provisions of Sections 4(c).

ii) No person shall cause a vehicle to make a U-Turn between intersections, and at the intersection of a highway with a lane or an alley in the municipality.

(j) VEHICLES ON PUBLIC RESERVE ETC.

- i) No person may operate or park a vehicle on any area designated in Appendix 12, "Public Reserves etc."

- ii) The provisions of subsection (i) shall not apply to maintenance vehicles, vehicles using a designated parking area or vehicles the owners of which have been granted written permission to park or operate in areas designated in Appendix 12, or portions thereof, by the administrator or a special constable of the municipality.

(k) BICYCLES

- i) No person shall operate a bicycle on a sidewalk.

(l) SNOWMOBILES

- i) Notwithstanding the provisions contained in subsection one of Section 21 of the Snowmobile Act, revised statutes of Saskatchewan, 1978 (and subject to Section G-2) it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10: p.m. on any public highway except Broadway Street and further excepting Provincial Highways No. 13 and 8 within the limits of the Municipality.

- ii) Notwithstanding subsection L(i), it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on Broadway Street and Provincial Highways 13 and 8 for the purposes of crossing said highways.

(m) ROADS CLOSED TEMPORARILY

- i) No driver shall drive or ride on any highway which is roped, barricaded or indicated, as being closed, by notice or sign erected by authority of the municipality.

(n) VEHICLE REPAIRS

- i) No vehicle repairs or changing of tires shall be made on any highway except in an emergency.

(o) LOADING ZONES

- 1) No operator of a vehicle shall remain in a loading zone for a period exceeding five (5) minutes for the purpose of loading or unloading passengers.

- 2) No operator of a vehicle shall remain in a loading zone for a period exceeding ten (10) minutes for the purpose of loading or unloading goods.

4. SIGNS

- (a) Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at the right-hand side of every street intersecting a "Stop" street as listed in Appendix 1 at a distance of approximately three (3) meters from the point of intersection, an appropriate sign containing the word "STOP". Such signs shall be so placed that it will face traffic which is approaching the "Stop" street.

- (b) Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at the right-hand side of every street intersecting a "Yield" street as listed in Appendix 2 at a distance of approximately three (3) meters from such intersections, an appropriate "Yield" sign. Such sign shall be so placed

that it will face traffic which is approaching the "yield" street.

(c) Council shall cause to be erected and maintained at intersections designated as "NO U-TURN" intersections as listed in Appendix 3 at a distance of approximately three (3) meters from the point of intersection signs prohibiting U-Turns.

(d) Council shall cause to be erected and maintained appropriate signs or curb markings to indicate "No Parking" areas as listed in Appendix 8 such signs or curb markings shall be visible from that part of the highway to which the restriction applies.

(e) Council may by resolution provide for the erection and maintenance on any highway, and at any designated point or points thereon, of such signs as it may deem expedient for giving warning, directions or information thereon.

#### 5. EMERGENCY CONTROL

(a) All traffic on highways and sidewalks shall, notwithstanding the provisions of this bylaw, be subject to any temporary emergency direction of the Council, including but not limited to the following: relieving congestion of traffic, preventing accidents or meeting unforeseen conditions.

(b) School bus safety lights: No person shall activate the safety lights or stop sign on a school bus when loading or unloading passengers.

#### 6. PENALTIES

(a) Shall be as listed in Appendix 15.

(b) Notice of Violation shall be in Form "2", Appendix 14, attached to and forming part of this bylaw or summary offence ticket procedure, Appendix 13 attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

(c) For the purposes of this bylaw service of Notice of Violation shall include:

i) Personal service of the Notice of Violation to the violator.

ii) Attachment of a Notice of Violation to a vehicle operated or parked in violation of the provisions of this bylaw.

iii) Where the postal address of the person to be served is known a Notice of Violation may be served by mailing a copy thereof by registered mail with post office acknowledgement of receipt card signed by the person to be served.

(d) Where no specific penalty is set out for a contravention of this By-Law, the penalty for such contravention shall be determined by the penalties set out in the Vehicles Act, the Summary Offences Procedure Act Regulations and any amendments thereto.

(e) Where a specified penalty is stated for the contravention of any of the provisions of this By-Law, a person charged with such contravention by service of the notice of violation or summons may dispose of the charge in the manner prescribed below.

(i) A person so charged is not required to appear in Court in answer to the summons if, on or before the due date for payment set out in the summons he:

- signs the plea of guilty endorsed on the summons,
- delivers the summons and the specified penalty sum to the place stated on the summons.



(ii) where a summons and the specified penalty sum are delivered to the place stated on the summons on or before the due date:

- a plea of guilty is deemed to have been entered by the person charged, whether or not the plea of guilty is signed on the summons;
- the person charged is deemed to have been convicted whether or not the information is sworn.

All matters of procedure not specifically dealt with by the provisions of this By-Law shall be determined by the Summary Offences Procedure Act S.S. Chapter S - 63 and any amendments thereto and such Act and amendments shall apply to this By-Law, mutatis mutandis.

#### 7. IMPOUNDING

(a) Any special constable or other person appointed by Council may remove or cause to be removed any vehicle that is unlawfully placed, left or kept on any highway or lane, public parking place, other public place, or municipally owned property, and to impound or store such vehicle.

(b) Where a vehicle has been impounded or stored after it has been removed under subsection (a), it may be retained at a place designated by Council for a period of thirty (30) days from date of removal unless the cost of removal, impounding and storage are sooner paid. upon payment of the full costs herein, the vehicle may be released to the owner thereof.

(c) If the costs of removal, impounding and storage are not paid within the period of thirty (30) days as specified in subsection (b), the municipality shall have the right to recover same from the owner of the vehicle by:

- 1) legal action in a court of competent jurisdiction.
- ii) sale by public auction on publication of a notice designating the time and place of sale at least fourteen (14) days prior to the sale in a newspaper circulating in the municipality and on sending such notice by registered mail to the owner at the address appearing on the last registration of the vehicle.

#### 8. REPEALING FORMER BYLAWS

(a) Bylaw No.'s 293/92, 335/96, 346/96, 363/97, 381/97, 402/98, 408/99, 409/99 are hereby repealed.

(b) This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval of the Highway Traffic Board.

(2) I will, when operating such lug vehicle over any bridge or culvert on any highway or on any highway or on any specified bridge or culvert thereon, first lay down on such bridge or culvert planks or timbers of not less than 5 cm in thickness or less than 4 meters in length, such planks or timbers to be laid lengthways across the bridge or culvert in the direction in which the lug vehicle is proceeding in such a manner that they will support the wheels or tread of the lug vehicle on both sides thereof throughout its entire passage over such bridge or culvert.

(3) I will pay for all damages caused to such highway of to any bridge or culvert thereon as a result of propelling, operating or driving such lug vehicle thereon.
