With the dawning of March though, there are new sprouts of hope: people talking about starting tomatoes or discussing the flower possibilities of their climate zone. In a way, it's like a support group. We are all together in this cold, muddy limbo - just hanging on till we can get outside and do something constructive. There is always comfort in numbers.

So, for this next little while, I think I will treat my Face book feed as my picture window. Why look out at dreary and dismal when I can look in and be warmed by hope?

The proposed by-law amendment is
as follows:

6. Term of Office

The Term of office of a Director shall be for **three** years, except for Directors appointed or elected in the first year of operation of the Foundation. In that case, half of the Board shall be elected or appointed for one year and the other half for two years. Any vacancy occurring between elections can be filled in the discretion of the Board of Directors, by appointment.

A retiring Director shall be eligible for re-election or re-appointment to a **maximum of two terms.**

Attention farmers and ranchers: What projects do you have planned for your operation this year?

Are you thinking of any of the following:

- Seeding annual cropland to perennial forages?
- Digging a new dugout or making an existing dugout larger?
- Putting in a new water well?
- Fencing off a creek and making riparian paddocks?
- Decommissioning an old water well?
- Putting in a pipeline for watering livestock?
- Improving or relocating livestock facilities to reduce runoff issues downstream?
- Improving existing drainage projects to reduce erosion?
- Developing zone maps for variable rate fertilizer application?
- Or maybe you have other new and innovative ideas?

Did you know that there are programs available that provide cost-share funding to eligible producers to do these projects and more? Funding levels vary from 30% to 90%, with most eligible projects being covered at 50%.

Staff with the Lower Souris Watershed Committee can help you access these programs by providing information, determining eligibility, providing or directing you to appropriate technical support, and walking you through the application process; basically a one-stop-shop.

Many of these projects require pre-approval in order to be eligible for the funding, so give Karmen Kyle a call at 306.452.7953 or email at karmen@lowersouris.com for more information on the various programs and how to apply. We look forward to hearing from you.
