**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 647-2019, A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING, PROHIBITING,
REGULATING AND CONTROL OF ANIMALS IN THE TOWN OF REDVERS**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to amend the Animal Control Bylaw,
NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Redvers, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw 647-2019 be amended in the manner hereinafter set forth.
2. That **PART V – GENERAL, 30. a)** Shall now read:
No person shall possess or harbour more than four (4) dogs or four (4) cats, or a combination of both, for a total of four (4) over the age of six months, but excluding:
 - i) A veterinary hospital, clinic, boarding kennel or grooming parlor;
 - ii) A public pound;
 - iii) A shop whose business includes the sale of pets and is licensed as such;
 - iv) A shelter operated by an association of society incorporated for the purpose of the protection and humane treatment of animals.
3. That any current household possessing more than four (4) dogs or four (4) cats, or a combination of both, for a total of four (4) over the age of six months, shall register all dogs and cats and be grandfathered in by council resolution. If grandfathered in by August 30, 2019 or when moving into the Town of Redvers, the owner shall not be in contravention of this bylaw, after council approval.
4. The Town C.A.O. or designated person shall keep a record of all grandfathered owners on file.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect June 12, 2019.
