Great Cycle Challenge started in 2016, and after just 4 years, the event has grown to become one of the biggest cycling events across Canada.

People of all ages, abilities and from every province across the country set themselves a personal riding goal and challenge themselves to pedal throughout August to fight kids' cancer.

In 3 years, our community of riders from all 13 provinces and territories have ridden a total of 10,294,551 kilometers, and together we raised \$12,412,026 in support of research to develop treatments and find a cure for childhood cancer.

Why? Because cancer is the largest killer of children from disease in Canada. Over 1,400 Canadian children are diagnosed with cancer every year.

We're riding to give these kids the brighter futures they deserve, and we believe that any one individual can make their personal impact to fight cancer and save little lives.

So we're calling on all Canadians to get on their bikes and join our movement to kick cancer's butt!

Great Cycle Challenge is a national <u>SickKids</u> <u>Foundation</u> fundraising initiative held throughout August.

I have personally rode over 400klms at this writing and will continue to ride for the rest of August. I would like to thank all that have made donations for this cause. The challenge continues to the end of August and donations are welcome.



So remember – not only is an instant meal a great idea during busy harvest time, but you will be helping Tourism out as well! Last, but not least, Tourism still has the fireworks we ordered for Canada Day. Nothing is for sure yet, but if it works out we will be donating them to end off the Winterfest activities in December. We shall see if Covid-19 lets us end 2020 on a happy, hopeful note!





SEPTEMBER 2020 HAVEN HAPPENINGS






