

**FIRE RATES BYLAW 662-2021**  
**TOWN OF REDVERS**  
**REDVERS, SASK.**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REDVERS IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING FIRE RATES IN THE TOWN OF REDVERS.**

The Council of the Town of Redvers in the province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

**SHORT TITLE**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Fire Rates Bylaw.

**PURPOSE**

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish the following rates:
  - a) Costs to be charged for fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services;
  - b) Other rates for firefighter meetings, practices, honorarium and administration.

**DEFINITIONS**

3. In this bylaw,
  - a) "Active Call" shall mean any call where the fire fighters leave the fire hall for fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services;
  - b) "C.A.O." shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - c) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
  - d) "Fire Department" shall mean the Redvers Fire Department;
  - e) "Non-Active Calls" shall mean any time for which the fire fighters partake in meetings, training and conferences;
  - f) "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Redvers;
  - g) "R.M." shall mean the Rural Municipality No. 61; and
  - h) "Service" shall mean fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services;

**FIRE RATES**

4. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged:
  - a) Directly to the property owner where the service occurred; or
  - b) To the R.M. directly in the event of the service being in the Rural Municipality No. 61.
5. All are in accordance with:
  - a) "Schedule A" which is attached and forming a part of this bylaw;
  - b) All invoices are the responsibility of the property owner or the R.M. and it is their legal obligation to provide payment to the Fire Department;
  - c) The Fire Department will invoice all property owners or the R.M. within one month of the service; and
  - d) That the fire rates listed in Schedule "A" of this bylaw will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Municipality and R.M. joint Fire Committee.
6. That the Fire Department will provide services to their area as outlined in Schedule "B" of this bylaw. And the fire rates outlined in Schedule "A" of this bylaw are to correspond with the service area.
7. To ensure all active and non active calls are invoiced correctly and accurately.

**ENFORCEMENT OF THE BYLAW**

8. The administration and enforcement of this bylaw is hereby delegated by the C.A.O. of the municipality.

9. The C.A.O. can hereby authorize to designate officers for the purpose of enforcing this bylaw.
10. That Council may authorize the C.A.O. to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 4 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
11. Nothing in this agreement is meant to counteract any other agreements between the Red Coat Mutual Aid, other Rural Municipalities, Town's, etc.

**NOTICE OF VIOLATION OFFENCES**

12. Any person who contravenes the provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than:
  - a) For the first offence of \$250;
  - b) For the second offence of \$400;
  - c) For the third or subsequent offence of not less than \$500.00 and not more than \$5,000.

**SEVERABILITY**

13. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or other portion of this Bylaw is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, that portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and the holding of the Court shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Bylaw.

**REPEAL OF EXISTING BYLAW**

14. Bylaw No. 644-2019 be hereby repealed.

**EFFECTIVE DATE OF BYLAW**

15. This Bylaw shall be effective as of March 3, 2021, the date the rates were set by the Joint Redvers Fire Protection Committee.

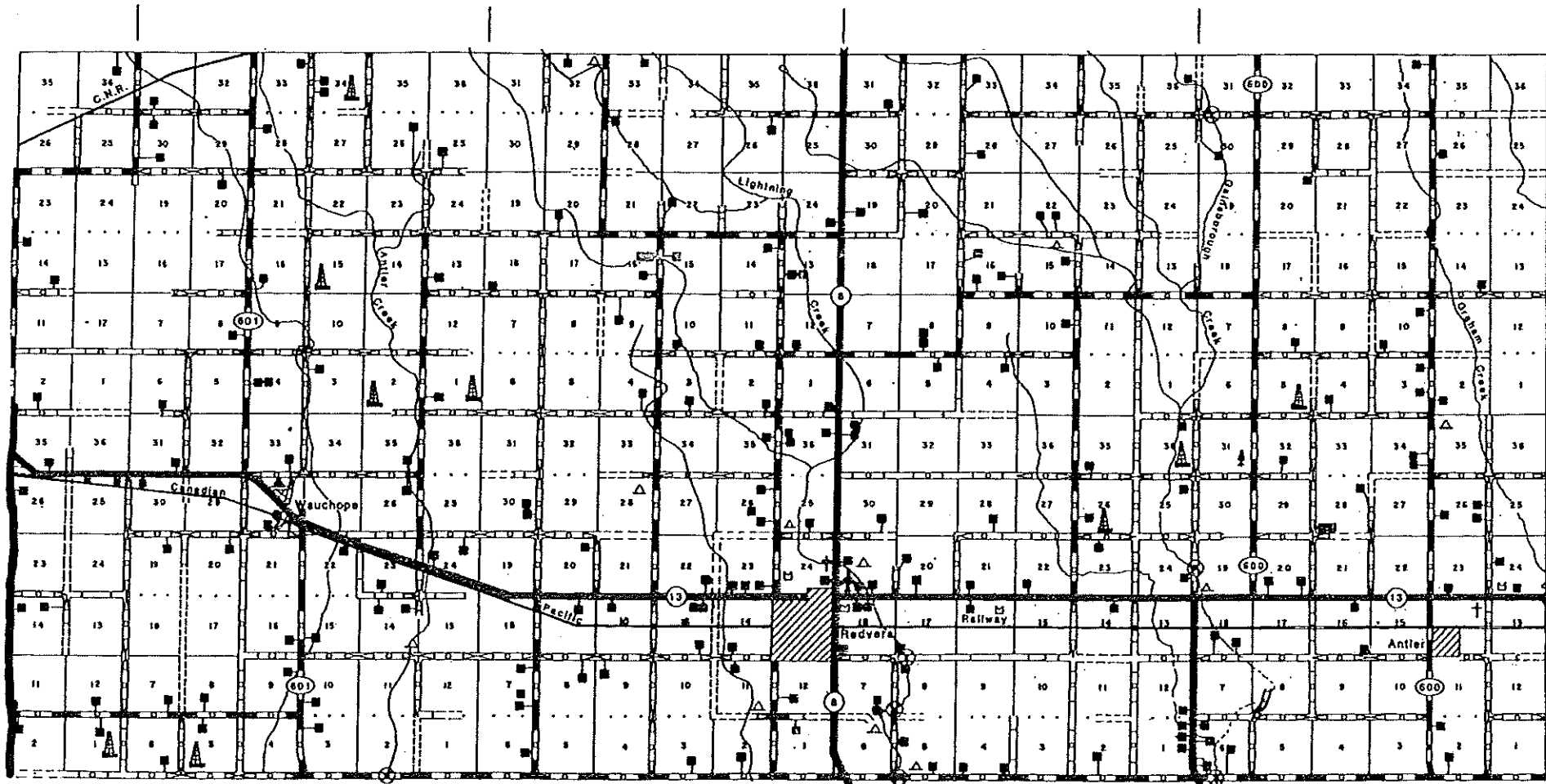
