

OPERATION OF GOLF CART BYLAW NO. 669-2022
TOWN OF REDVERS
REDVERS, SASK.

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REDVERS TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF A GOLF CART ON THE PUBLIC ROADWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF REDVERS.

The Council of the Town of Redvers, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short Title:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as operation of a golf cart on public roadways and Recreation Grounds within the town limits.

Definitions:


2. "Golf Cart" as prescribed in The Traffic Safety Act.
3. "Recreation Grounds" as defined and outlined in Schedule "A" of this Bylaw.


Regulations:

4. Persons operating a golf cart must be using the cart for the sole purpose of travelling to/from the Recreation Grounds, using the shortest, most direct route between the Recreation Grounds and where the golf cart is stored.
5. No one shall operate a golf cart on a public roadway within the limits of the Town of Redvers without a valid class 7 driver's license, abiding by all SGI regulations and requirements.
6. It shall be lawful to operate a golf cart during the hours one-half hour prior to sunrise and one half-hour after sunset on all public roadways within the limits of the Town of Redvers, with the exception of any sidewalk, boulevard, schoolyard, park, or playground.
7. No one shall operate a golf cart on Provincial Highways No. 13 and No. 8 within the limits of the Town of Redvers, except for crossing.
8. Owners must carry a minimum of \$200,000 in third-party liability insurance and all personal and public liability will be the responsibility of the operator of the golf cart.
9. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00.
10. That Bylaw #629-2017 is hereby repealed.

11. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval thereof by Saskatchewan Government Insurance.

"Recreation Grounds" are public lands which are used for sports and other activities both indoors and outdoors. The Town of Redvers' Recreation Grounds are located west of Methuen Street and houses the following buildings, designated areas and community organizations:

Recreation Centre, Agriculture Society Arena, Redvers & District Golf Course and Clubhouse, Redvers Ball Diamonds, Redvers Tourism Booth/Log Cabin, Park and Campground.

The below map includes all areas that are considered Recreation Grounds and that the golf cart can travel to/from. The area inside of the red marks the boundary permitting the use of golf carts.
