REDVERS ARTS COUNCIL PRESENTS THE LAST BIRDS

Valentine's Day is coming up quickly and the Redvers Arts Council has planned a great opportunity for an evening of food, drink and entertainment for singles, couples, and anyone who likes an outing.

On Friday, February 14th, the Redvers Legion will be the location for cocktails, a supper catered by Weirs, and two sets of music from the Last Birds. The Last Birds are a husband/wife duo from North Portal, Mike Davis and Lindsay Arnold. Their two voices, two guitars approach is steeped in early country folk influence and provides an intimate storytelling experience audiences have repeatedly described as mesmerizing. Using their small prairie hometown as a backdrop, Last Birds harmonize and weave together rural legends and current day experiences to form a modern prairie gothic. Their songs veer away from overly romanticized views of small town life to peer into the dark corners of the local bar, peek in the windows of an abandoned house down the street and pine for something or someone beyond the veil.

This past month they were nominated for two Saskatchewan Music Association awards including Roots/Folk Artist of the Year. Their first full-length album Endless Turn of Day Into Night won Alternative Country Album of the Year at the 2024 Saskatchewan Country Music Awards. Last Birds as musical entertainment following an always-great supper and dessert from Weirs is bound to make a great evening of food, fun, and relaxation.

Tickets are \$60 each and available now. Ticket purchase deadline is Fri, Feb 7th (to allow for catering planning). Cash bar, door prizes and 50/50 are also planned for the night of the 14th. MAINTENANCE CONTRACTOR

This is a contract position responsible for the maintenance of the buildings and grounds of the housing authority units in Redvers. The maintenance contractor receives general direction from the manager and reports indirectly to the Board of Directors.

The Redvers Housing Authority manages a portfolio consisting of a combination of 48 Senior & Family Housing units.

The successful contractor is to provide or subcontract the following services:

- Routine janitorial services.
- Routine grounds maintenance, including snow removal and lawn care.
- Minor maintenance of common areas and rental units including repairs and/or replacements.
- Accessibility to Housing Authority tenants for emergency repairs.
- Maintenance of inventories and equipment.
- Regular building, unit and vacant unit inspections.
- Boiler monitoring and maintenance.

The contractor must have excellent communication skills and be able to provide services cooperatively to individuals and groups of varying backgrounds. A high degree of discretion and confidentiality is required. A basic working knowledge of carpentry, plumbing, heating, electrical and general property maintenance practices as well as the ability to perform manual labor and lifting tasks is required. Contractor to provide all tools and equipment including personal vehicle and cell phone.

The preference is for a single contractor to perform all required services however, the Redvers Housing Authority reserves the right to consider separate applications for janitorial, grounds or maintenance services or any combination.

The preferred candidate will be required to complete a Criminal Record Check including a vulnerable sector check prior to the offer of and appointment to a position.

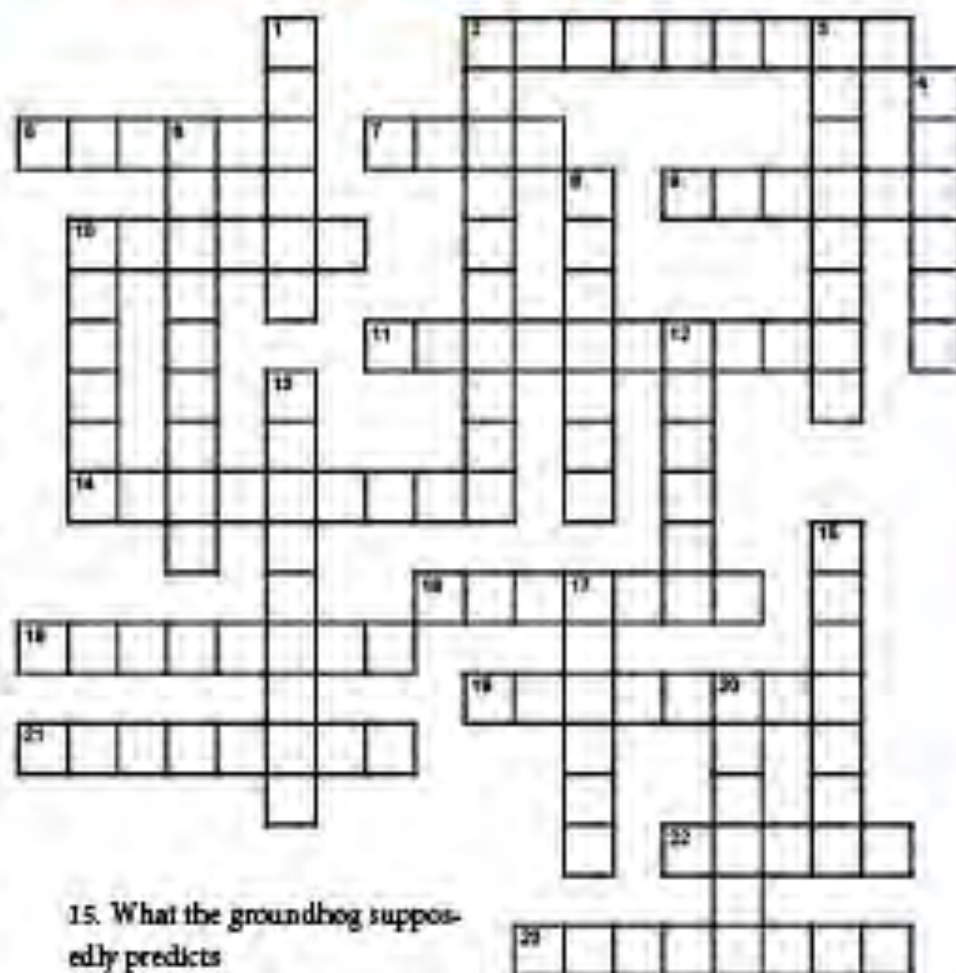

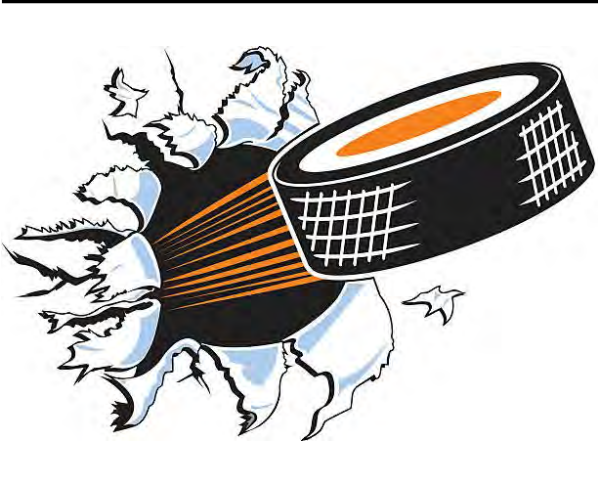

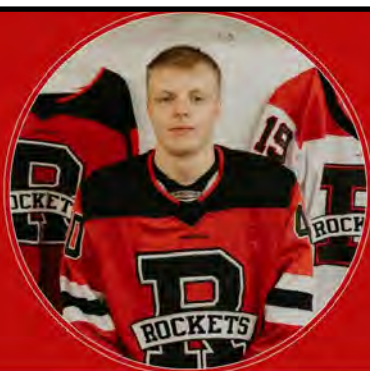

It has a nice ring to it, doesn't it?

Hockeyville, Canada. It could be anywhere in Canada.

And, if we play our cards right, it could be here.

Have you seen the ads about Redvers participating in Kraft's Hockeyville contest this winter? I'm sure it's been discussed at coffee row, and in the bleachers while watching games or practices at the rink, but in case you're out of the loop I thought I would tell you a bit more about it.

2025 marks the 19th year that this competition has been offered to communities across Canada. The benefit a town can earn from being a part of this is getting the chance to showcase our hometown heart and love of the Canadian game. Of course, the prize of \$250,000 to be spent towards arena upgrades and improvements should we win would sure be nice too.

The contest is open to every arena in the country, large and small. Population really has little to do with the chance to win. While the contest is centered on our national game winning depends on local team spirit. Anyone who has been to a hockey game knows that a game played without the fan/crowd energy cheering the players on is a sad, silent affair. It's the feedback loop of goals-cause-cheering and cheering-incites-goals that make the game fun. It will be exactly this kind of energy that will put Redvers over the top, should we all harness its power. We will need everyone, not just the folks who practically live at the rink from October till the end of March. If you want the world to see Redvers in a positive light step up to the plate here. Every single vote will count.

We are at the starting line right now; first things first - we need to get our town nominated.

The contest rules set out that we need to 'write stories' describing why Redvers should qualify and how we would use the prize money should we win. Writing a story sounds intimidating to most people but when you look into it all they are asking for is to answer three questions. It's pretty straight forward, and to make it even more user friendly, our Rec Director, Nadine, hosted a "help you out" afternoon at the rink last week and has another one planned at the Library on Feb 13. Just show up with your phone and your e-mail address and someone will help you write and send your 'story'. If you have any photos (anything from a rosy-cheeked grandchild celebrating his/her first goal to the team handshake at the end of a senior's final) bring that too. Stories gain us 10 points toward nomination, photos earn 3 points and notes give us 1. Nadine will be able to help you with everything. We need these points to get us to the next level. We have until March 2 to get this done.

Communities who earn a nomination will then have to gather votes to win. As I said, population size is not a limiting factor. Last year, when it came down to the final four, they were Enderby, BC pop. 3,028, Cochrane, AB pop. 32,199, Elliot Lake, ON pop. 11,372, and Wolseley, SK pop. 864. Elliot Lake won, but Wolseley wasn't last. It's that team spirit thing again. They obviously were winners at selling up their community: pretty impressive and maybe we can ask them for pointers if we get that far.

But, first things first! Let's get our name up on the scoreboard. Get your submissions in, tell a friend, or two, or six. There is only one submission allowed per email address so we need lots of people - or people with lots of emails - or lots of people with multiple addresses! Let's get this done Redvers!

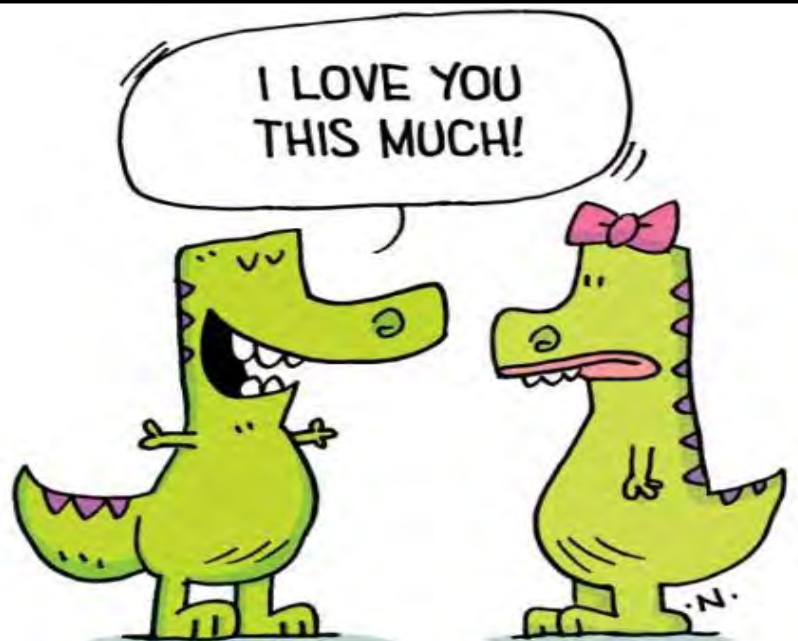
